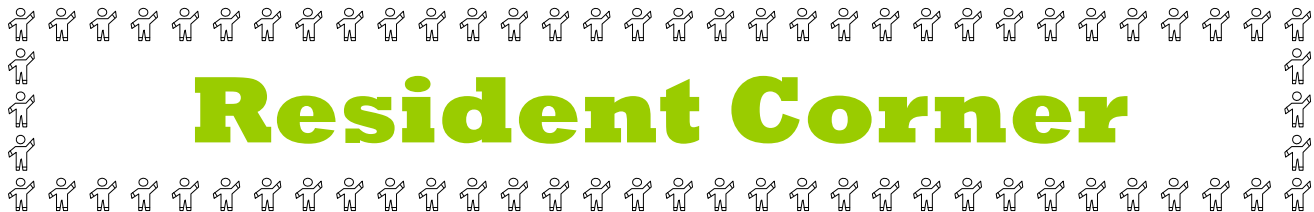


March 19 9:45 Shopping at Towne Center Mall. You'll have 2 and 1/2 hours to shop.
